

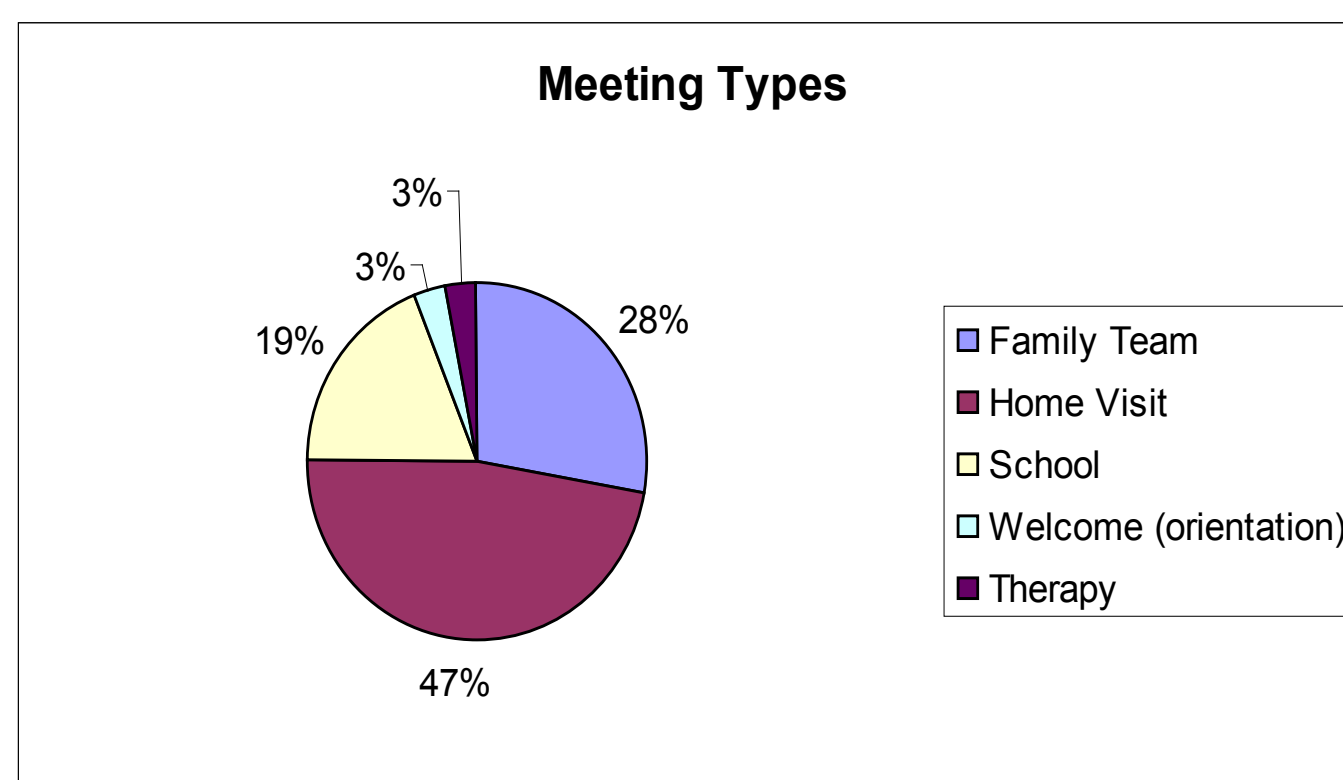
2-month snapshot of the work of a Parent Advocate



The Cuyahoga Tapestry System of Care uses a data collection tool called the Parent Advocate Activity Form to track how Parent Advocates interact with families and to improve their services. Data below represent the activities of ONE Parent Advocate over a two-month period.
